Reminder to Members Tips for Good Trips

The first bus trip has come and gone so please remember, the bus departs Scarsdale at **6PM**. Please be on time!! If you are unfamiliar with the Scarsdale Pool Parking Lot location please contact the Trip Leader.

Also please pack your skis or board in a bag of some kind, this protects your equipment and prevents damage to other members equipment. Ski Boots cannot be worn on the Club provided bus. Please bring your dinner for the ride, while we have snacks and beverages, there is no planned food stop on our trip up Friday night.

Again, if you have any questions, please contact the Trip Leader

Please be aware of designated departure times, such as departing the Scarsdale Pool Parking Lot at 6PM.

This means the bus leaves at 6PM, not come screeching into the parking lot at 6PM. When leaving the hotel in the morning or departing the mountain in the evening, it means being on the bus at the designated times. Please be considerate of your fellow club members.

Trip Sign-ups

The proper way to sign-up for an event is to come to a meeting and sign-up and hand the trip leader a check, if you can't get to a meeting you **MUST** contact the trip leader to see if space is available and then send the trip leader a check. Simply sending a check to the P.O. Box or even the trip leader, unannounced, **does not hold your space**. Without prior notification the trip leader has no idea you are interested and is free to sell the space, 1st come 1st served. If a check is received without prior notification your name will be added to the trip list, if space is available at the time the check comes into the possession of the trip leader. If no space is available at the time the check comes into the possession of the trip leader, the check will be returned and the person's name will be added to the wait list.

Please make all checks payable to the club as "**Mogul Meister Ski Club**". Some banks will no longer accept checks with the acronym "**MMSC**".
